It is a subsidiary of Grupo Meridional SA de CV, a company founded in 1936 and today one of Mexico's leading diversified industrial companies, operating four core businesses: steel processing; automotive batteries and related products; steel and plastic construction products; and aluminum and related products. With manufacturing and distribution facilities in Mexico, the United States, and Central and South America, Grupo MERIDIONAL exports to all seven continents. In 2001 Grupo Meridional's sales reached US\$2.3 billion, of which close to 45% was generated outside Mexico. Grupo Meridional shares trade on the Mexican Stock Exchange (MERD).
